As her career progresses with management and labels, Ellysse still loves to hark back to her days as a DIY artist, taking an active part in the production of the music, designing her own artwork and imagery and hand making merchandise.



Having mastered the dark art of social media, Ellysse has racked up over **430k dedicated** followers across her platforms, and more importantly, a following that is reflected in her **200k monthly Spotify listeners** and over **4 million accumulative streams**.



Alongside her loyal fanbase, Ellysse has also gained the support of industry professionals with regular international and regional radio play with the likes of BBC Radio 1 and Radio 6, as well as being championed by BBC Introducing.

Live, she is reaching huge audiences and selling out headline shows at The Deaf Institute, Band On The Wall and Manchester Academy 3. in 2021 she appeared at festivals such as Live at Leeds & Dot to Dot (Bristol & Nottingham) and is due to play at Kendal Calling 2022 and 110 Above.
